You bring the energy, the commitment and the passion for local government and we will help you navigate the road to become an elected official.

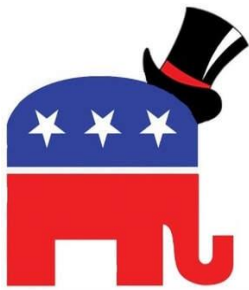
